

## **PTO February Meeting Minutes**

March 1, 2024

Called to order at 12:03 pm

### **I. Approval of 1/19/24 Board Meeting Minutes**

- a) J. Terracina made a motion to approve; L. Blasingame second; motion passed

### **II. President's Update**

- a) Teacher grants have been approved and orders are in process; all grants will be fulfilled by April.
- b) Playground Improvement – following up with CISD to schedule meeting with Mr. McCord to discuss latest information regarding what we can and can't do to upgrade the playground and explore option that would fit within CISD's guidelines and plans for the upcoming new gym.

### **III. Communications**

- a) Spring Membership – Line Dancing event is set and will take place mainly in the cafeteria, with the food truck parked on the bus ramp for those who wish to purchase food. The basketball courtyard will be set up with tables and chairs for people to seat in eat. We have approximately 147 people who RSVPd for event. Spirit of Joy confirmed that we can park on their lot. Team needs additional volunteers to help direct people on where to go.

### **IV. Services**

- a) Academic Outreach – Awaiting feedback from Mrs. Thompson on which days in May to schedule the Bubble Show and Raptor presentations.
- b) School Supplies – Committee began gathering feedback from grade level leads to begin compiling list of supplies for next year. Working with the new vendor to get kit costs by grade. Anticipate having school supplies on sale by first week in April.
- c) Yearbooks – so far, we have sold 394 yearbooks and have approximately 131 left. We sold 35 ads; deadline for ad content is March 15.

### **V. Fundraising**

- a) Bonanza – the planning committee is meeting later to talk about logistics for the event.
  - Silent auction committee came up with a list of Bush experiences and we're sharing with Mrs. Thompson for her approval.
  - Food Committee is finalizing details based on confirmed available budget; will likely proceed with 2 slices of pizza, salad, two drinks and a cookie per person.
  - Entertainment – all has been booked, but waiting confirmation on a potential sponsor to cover the Watch Dogs Dunk Tank.
  - Children's Raffle – all items have been secured and will be packaged for the event. The raffle will be previewed during lunch on April 3, and kids can drop off tickets during their PE time on April 4 and 5.
