### **WILL MY STUDENT RECEIVE A T-SHIRT?**

YES! All students and staff will receive a blue Bucks for Bush T-shirt. Shirts will be delivered to your student's classroom before the run. Students can slip the shirt over what they wore to school or change like they did for previous fun runs.

### **CAN STUDENTS WEAR FESTIVE ATTIRE?**

YES! We encourage students to wear festive accessories and comfy shoes.

### **WHAT CAN WE EXPECT?**

The Jingle Bell Run will be structured like other fun runs. Students will be shown a route to follow and there will be a DJ hosting the run. There will be music, holiday décor, a snow machine, photo opp, and a snow cone at the end!

### **HOW LONG WILL STUDENTS RUN?**
